offer enough reasons for whisky lovers to re-think a potential abstinence:

Limited edition: Soccer-Whisky

This special bottling is the result of an artist meeting a whisky-loving soccer fan.

The gift sets consist of 3 different Single Cask Scotch Malt Whiskies bottled at cask strength, whose distinct characteristics symbolise the different play situations:



TWC Lochranza (Arran) 10 yrs
1996 - 2006 55,5%vol. – Sherry Butt

TWC Dailuaine 20 yrs
1985 - 2006 53,3%vol. – Oak Cask

TWC Glen Spey 28 yrs
1977 - 2005 58,9%vol

Only a total of **10 Sets with serial numbers** have been bottled. The price of a set of 3 x 200 ml of cask strength Single Malt Whisky is 169 €.

Set No. 1 comes along with the original painting of the artist that was used as sample for the special label – and is on offer for 299 €.

Arriving anytime soon from Scotland I am expecting the latest addition to our series of [“The Whisky Chamber private bottlings”](#):

- **Rosebank 17 years** (silent still)
1991 56,3 %vol - bourbon cask
- **Strathisla 18 years**
1989 63,5 %vol - Sherry cask

With some of the first bottlings coming to an end, I wanted to be sure to maintain a full range of typical whiskies for the different Scottish whisky regions – and eventually add a representative of the Lowlands, which I personally think are largely underestimated.



Springbank Whisky-School

During this summer I will be touring Scotland again on my continuous quest for promising whisky casks.

In addition to that, I will spend a week of hands-on whisky making experience at Springbank's "[Whisky-School](#)".

While many distilleries have started similar courses, Springbank's offer is very special (not least, because some Springbanks are my absolute favourites). As far as I know they are one of the few distilleries that actually still perform the full whisky making process from the malting of the barley through to the final bottling – and allow the "pupils" to actively participate in the job!
